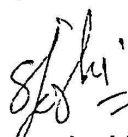
S.No.	Program Name	Duration	Date	Target Audience
1.	Infrastructure Finance	05 days	27 th to 31 st July, 2026	Government officials in Central or State Govt/ Semi Govt entities/CPSEs or State PSUs/ ULBs, finance professionals, project managers, policy makers, and anyone interested in the field of infrastructure finance. Prior knowledge of basic finance principles is recommended. The course would have significant take-aways for junior and middle levels officials.
2.	Workshop on Public-Private Partnership (PPP) for Middle Management level Officer	03 days	3 rd to 5 th August, 2026	The workshop is tailored for government officials, project managers, investors, financial analysts, and professionals involved in infrastructure development and public service delivery. The participants must have either attended a basic program on PPP or are having at least 3 years of exposure in the area of PPP/Infra Sector planning/execution/Financing etc.
3.	Infrastructure in India: Sectoral Studies	5-days	17 th to 21 st August, 2026	Policymakers, Infrastructure Professionals, Urban Planners, Investment Analysts, Government Officials, and Industry Leaders. The participants may ideally, have around 0-3 years of work experience in dealing with procurement. The course would have significant take-aways for junior and middle levels officials.
4.	End-to-End Infrastructure Project Management: Appraisal, DPR & Execution	5-days	7 th to 11 th September, 2026	Government Officials, Infrastructure Project Managers, Financial Analysts, Engineers, Urban Planners, and other stakeholders in infrastructure development. The participants may ideally, have around 0-3 years of work experience in dealing with procurement. The course would have significant take-aways for junior and middle levels officials.
5.	Workshop on Public-Private Partnership (PPP) for Leadership level Officer	03 days	16 th to 18 th September, 2026	The workshop is tailored for senior government officials, project managers, investors, financial analysts, and professionals involved in infrastructure development and public service delivery. The participants must have completed around 14 years of service with at least 3 years of exposure in the area of PPP/Infra Sector planning/execution/Financing etc.

6.	Public-Private Partnership (PPP) – A Basic Perspective	05 days	5 th to 9 th October, 2026	Officials in Management, Engineering, Commercial and Finance area, or any other relevant officials dealing with various facts of procurement of PPP projects in Central or State Govt/Semi Govt entities/CPSEs or State PSUs/ULBs dealing with Public Procurement of Works and Services. The participants may ideally, have around 0-3 years of work experience in dealing with procurement. The course would have significant take-aways for junior and middle levels officials.
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3. Accordingly, nominations of suitable officers from your Ministry/Department/Organisation are invited for the above-mentioned training programmes. Since each programme has limited capacity (approximately 35 participants), nominations in the prescribed proforma may be forwarded to DEA at least 10 days prior to commencement of the programme to facilitate necessary arrangements.

4. The training fee, boarding and lodging charges of the selected participants shall be borne by the Department of Economic Affairs. Confirmation regarding selection of nominated officers will be communicated separately by DEA. A Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for the nomination process is enclosed for reference.
